CAMPEA Multi-Service Centers for the Elderly

The Multi-Service Centers for the Elderly (CAMPEA, for its Spanish acronym) are geared towards people aged 60 or older. At these centers, they spend part of the day with their peers and receiving care and support services that contribute to their safety and wellbeing.

Older adults receive the following services:

- **Transportation:** Each center has been assigned a vehicle, along with a driver and an escort, to transport participants who live far away from the center or who need this service for a justified reason. Transportation can also be provided to participants in order for them to benefit from other community services.
- **Nutrition:** During their stay at the Center, participants are offered breakfast, lunch, and snacks. Meal delivery services are also offered. The menus consist of a balanced diet prepared by a nutritionist. The purpose of this service is to improve and maintain the health of participants.
- **Health:** A nurse is available at the Center to address the participant's health problems and to follow up on all medical recommendations.
- Social Services: A Family Services Technician or a Social Worker prepares a Service Plan based on the needs of each participant, so they are able to improve the quality of life of their families and their communities.
- Laundry: A washer and dryer are available at the Center to be used by qualifying participants, under staff supervision.
- **Socialization and Education:** A coordinator is in charge of organizing recreational, social, cultural, educational, and faith-based activities. These activities include excursions, arts and crafts, exercises, and adaptive recreation competitions, among others.

The CAMPEA centers operate in coordination with governmental and private agencies, in order to achieve an effective collaboration and to expand services and opportunities based on the participants' needs and interests.

Who can attend the CAMPEA centers?

Any qualifying person aged sixty (60) or older. For further information, please contact your nearest Department of the Family's Local Office or Integrated Services Center or call the Adult Services Program at (787) 625-4900.


